Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$2,976 in fiscal year 2025-26 and \$10,447 in fiscal year 2026-27 to the Maine Human Rights Commission to reclassify the existing Commission Counsel position from a Public Service Coordinator III position to a major policy-influencing position.
