2 3	Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §1252-A, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 705, Pt. G, §11, is amended to read:
4	1. Lists used. The lists of licensed drivers, persons issued an identification card by
5	the Secretary of State, registered voters from the central voter registration system, persons
6	to whom state income tax forms have been mailed, recipients of public assistance benefits,
7	recipients of state unemployment compensation and any person persons who notifies notify
8	the clerk of the court in the county of their residence and requests request to be put on the
9	source list of prospective jurors shall must serve as the source for prospective jurors in each
10	county. These lists may be supplemented with names from other lists specified by the
11	Supreme Judicial Court.
