This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" and does the following.

- 1. It changes the name of the fund established in the committee amendment.
- 2. It clarifies that the grant program established in the committee amendment is designed to encourage schools to adopt start times at or after 8:30 a,m.
- 3. It clarifies that plans to coordinate school start times among a school administrative unit's schools must allow secondary schools to start at or after 8:30 a.m. and removes the specification that the plans coordinate staggered start times.
- 4. It requires the Department of Education to adopt rules to ensure that grants administered through the grant program established in the amendment are administered in a manner that is equitable and fair,
