2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4801, sub-§2-B is enacted to read:
3 4 5	2-B. Start time. Beginning with the 2026-2027 school year, a school administrative unit shall ensure that a secondary school in the unit does not start a school day before 8:30 a.m.

7 3)	This bill requires that, beginning with the 2026-2027 school year, each school administrative unit ensure that its secondary schools' school days start no earlier than 8:30 a.m.
