10 Removal of Overboard Discharge Systems"

11 Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1, 2, 3 and 4.

12 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section
13 number to read consecutively.

14 **SUMMARY**

15 This amendment removes from the bill the provisions requiring a seller of residential
16 real property to disclose in the property disclosure statement provided to the purchaser the
17 use of an overboard discharge system on the property and a summary of the transfer
18 requirements for such a system.
