1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §13083-K, sub-§5 is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6 7 8 9	5. Prohibition on use of aqueous film-forming foam. Beginning January 1, 2026, a person may not discharge, test, store or otherwise use aqueous film-forming foam on any property leased or owned by the authority. The provisions of this subsection do not apply to actions performed in the course of the removal, abatement or remediation of aqueous film-forming foam. For purposes of this subsection, "aqueous film-forming foam" means a fire suppressant foam containing fluorinated surfactants intended for extinguishing flammable liquid fires. The Department of Environmental Protection shall enforce this
10 11	subsection in accordance with Title 38, section 347-A. SUMMARY
12 13 14 15	This bill prohibits the use of aqueous film-forming foam on any property leased or owned by the Midcoast Regional Redevelopment Authority, including the former Brunswick Naval Air Station, beginning January 1, 2026. It also assigns the enforcement of the prohibition to the Department of Environmental Protection.
