A person who is 21 18 years of age or older and is not otherwise prohibited from 19 possessing a firearm or is 18 years of age or older and under 21 years of age and is on 20 active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States or the National Guard or is an 21 honorably discharged veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States or the National 22 Guard and is not otherwise prohibited from carrying a firearm may have in or on a 23 vehicle a loaded pistol or revolver. This paragraph does not include a person who is 24 18 years of age or older, who meets the age requirement for enrollment under Title 25 20-A, section 5201, subsection 1 and who is currently enrolled in a public or private 26 secondary school in the State. 27 Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A-1 in the last line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by 28 inserting after the following: "firearm" the following: '. This paragraph does not include a 29 person who is 18 years of age or older, who meets the age requirement for enrollment under 30 Title 20-A, section 5201, subsection 1 and who is currently enrolled in a public or private 31 secondary school in the State' 32 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 33 number to read consecutively.

This amendment, which is the minority report, clarifies that a person who is 18 years of age or older, who has not reached 20 years of age and who is currently enrolled in a public or private secondary school in the State may not carry a concealed handgun without a valid permit.
