1 2	Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
3 4 5	Whereas, this legislation must take effect before the end of the 90-day period to ensure the law governing electric power and service residential rates for military veterans' organizations remains effective; and
6 7 8 9	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
10	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
11 12	Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §3109, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 244, §1, is amended to read:
13	3. Repeal. This section is repealed September 1, 2025 October 1, 2027.
14 15	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.

17 18 19	This bill changes, from September 1, 2025 to October 1, 2027, the repeal date of the law governing electric power and service residential rates for military veterans organizations.
