'Amend the bill in section 5 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2026" and inserting the following: '2027' '

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 6 and inserting the following:

Sec. 6. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.


