striking out the following: "January 1, 2026" and inserting the following: "December 31,  
2025"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 4 the following:

**'Sec. 5. Outside funding. Resolved:** That the Department of Health and Human  
Services may accept outside funding contributions to fully fund the costs of the working  
group under section 1.

**Sec. 6. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved:** That the following  
appropriations and allocations are made.
