1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§5, as amended by PL 2011, c. 548, §15, is further amended to read:
4 5 6 7	5. Medicines. Sales of medicines for human beings sold on a doctor's prescription. This subsection does not apply to the sale of marijuana and sales of cannabis on or after January 1, 2026 to a person with written certification for medical use provided by a medical provider pursuant to Title 22, chapter 558-C.
8	SUMMARY
9 10 11	This bill includes in the sales tax exemption that applies to medicines sold on a doctor's prescription sales of cannabis to a person who is certified for medical use by a medical provider pursuant to the Maine Medical Use of Cannabis Act.
