18 19 20 21 22	This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, stipulates that if there are no duties for an employer to assign to an employee who reports to work as a result of not receiving notice not to report to work, the employer must pay the employee the wages required by the bill for an employee who reports to work at the request of the employer and whose shift is cancelled or reduced.
