10 11 12 13	Amend the bill in section 2 in §639-A in subsection 1 in paragraph A in the last line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "1" the following: 'or an employee of a public employer, as defined in section 626, who is covered by a collective bargaining agreement'
14 15 16	Amend the bill in section 2 in §639-A in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 16 and 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ""Employer" does not include a public employer as defined in section 626."
17 18	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
19	SUMMARY
20 21 22	This amendment removes the provision in the bill that excludes public employers from the definition of "employer." It adds an exception to the definition of "employee" for an employee of a public employer who is covered by a collective bargaining agreement.
