4 5 6 7	1. Notice. For informing the public about contracts and grants for which proposals are being requested. Notice must also be provided prior to the 3rd renewal period of a contract, if applicable, or when a contract with a total value greater than \$1,000,000 is renewed;
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill amends the notice requirements to the public regarding state contracts and grants. The bill requires additional notice to the public when a state contract is renewed for
11 12	a 3rd renewal period or when a contract with a total value greater than \$1,000,000 is renewed.
