HOUSE AMENDMENT " L " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 377,
L.D. 609, "An Act Making Certain Appropriations and Allocations and Changing Certain
Provisions of Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part TT the following:

PART UU

Sec. UU-1. 20-A MRSA §14 is enacted to read:

§14. Prohibited participation of biological males in female sports; prohibited access
to locker rooms and restrooms designated for female use

An institution in the State that allows a biological male to participate in a sport
designated for female-only participation or allows a biological male to use a locker room
or restroom designated for female use may not receive funding from the State. For purposes
of this section, "biological male" refers to an individual's physical form as a male based
solely on the individual's reproductive biology and genetics at birth.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits institutions that allow a biological male to participate in a
sport designated for female-only participation or allow a biological male to use a locker
room or restroom designated for female use from receiving funding from the State.
