Amend the amendment by inserting after Part TT the following:

PART UU

Sec. UU-1. Filling vacant positions prohibited. Beginning on the effective date
of this Act through June 30, 2027, executive branch departments and agencies are
prohibited from filling vacant positions.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

This amendment provides that beginning on the effective date of this Act through June
30, 2027, executive branch departments and agencies are prohibited from filling vacant
positions.
