SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 414, L.D. 646, "Resolve, Establishing the Commission to Study Unregulated Storm Water Pollution"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd instructional paragraph (page 1, lines 13 to 15 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency preamble.'

Amend the amendment on page 2 by inserting before the last instructional paragraph the following:

'Amend the resolve in section 8 in the first line (page 2, line 30 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "December 3, 2025" and inserting the following: "December 1, 2026"


Amend the resolve in section 8 in the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 33 and 34 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Second Regular Session of the 132nd Legislature" and inserting the following: "133rd Legislature in 2027"

Amend the resolve by striking out all of the emergency clause.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the emergency preamble and emergency clause and changes the reporting date to December 1, 2026.
