2	<b>Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §723-A, sub-§2,</b> ¶ <b>A,</b> as enacted by IB 2015, c. 3, §5, is amended to read:
4 5	A. If there are 2 or fewer continuing candidates, the candidate with the most a majority of the votes cast in that round is declared the winner of the election.

7 8 9	This bill provides that, for the purposes of ranked-choice voting procedure, if there are 2 or fewer continuing candidates, the candidate with a majority of the votes cast in that round is declared the winner of the election.
