COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 310, L.D. 693, "An Act to Support the Department of the Secretary of State, Bureau of Corporations, Elections and Commissions"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Establishes 3 Office Specialist II positions and provides funding for All Other.
