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

Maine Criminal Justice Academy study; nonresidential training 17 program. Resolved: That the Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy shall convene a working group to study the feasibility of establishing a nonresidential law 18 19 enforcement training program within the Maine Criminal Justice Academy. 20 Sec. 2. Membership. Resolved: That the working group under section 1 consists 21 of the chair of the Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy, or the chair's 22 designee, and the following members appointed by the Board of Trustees of the Maine 23 Criminal Justice Academy: 24 1. A representative from a statewide association representing municipalities; 25 2. A representative from a statewide association of county commissioners; 3. A representative from a statewide association of chiefs of police; and 26 27 4. A representative from a statewide association of sheriffs. 28 Sec. 3. Report. Resolved: That, by January 1, 2026, the Board of Trustees of the 29 Maine Criminal Justice Academy shall submit a report to the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety that includes the findings and recommendations from 30 31 the working group convened pursuant to section 1, including suggested legislation. The 32 committee may report out legislation related to the report to the Second Regular Session of 33 the 132nd Legislature.'
