Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:
'An Act to Reimburse the City of Ellsworth for a Public Road to a New Court Facility in Hancock County'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:
'Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT

Courts - Supreme, Superior and District 0063

Initiative: Provides a one-time General Fund appropriation to reimburse the City of Ellsworth 33% of the costs incurred, up to \$500,000, for building a public road to facilitate access to the property on which the city is working with the judicial branch to build a new courthouse for Hancock County.
