1 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 3 Whereas, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A requires 4 legislative authorization before major substantive agency rules may be finally adopted by 5 the agency; and 6 Whereas, a major substantive rule has been submitted to the Legislature for review; 7 and 8 Whereas, immediate enactment of this resolve is necessary to record the Legislature's 9 position on final adoption of the rule; and 10 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 11 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 12 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 13 therefore, be it 14 **Sec. 1.** Adoption. Resolved: That final adoption of portions of Chapter 27: Standards for Timber Harvesting and Timber Harvesting Related Activities Within 15 Unorganized and Deorganized Areas of the State, a provisionally adopted major 16 17 substantive rule of the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Bureau of Forestry that has been submitted to the Legislature for review pursuant to the Maine 18 Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A, is authorized. 19 20 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation 21 takes effect when approved. 22 **SUMMARY** 23 This resolve provides for legislative review of portions of Chapter 27: Standards for 24 Timber Harvesting and Timber Harvesting Related Activities Within Unorganized and 25 Deorganized Areas of the State, a major substantive rule of the Department of Agriculture, 26 Conservation and Forestry, Bureau of Forestry.
