9 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 325, L.D. 767, "An Act to Amend the  
10 Laws Governing Licensing of Certain Types of Establishments and Professions by the  
11 Department of Health and Human Services"

12 Amend the bill in section 3 in §2504 in subsection 2 in paragraph B in the last line  
13 (page 2, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "disclose" and inserting the following:  
14 'determine the need for disclosure'

15 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section  
16 number to read consecutively.

17 **SUMMARY**

18 This amendment clarifies that the Commissioner of Health and Human Services may  
19 not delegate the decision to disclose the identity of a complainant or the investigative record  
20 when disclosure is necessary to avoid imminent or serious harm.
