It also reduces the maximum license amount from \$2,000 to 7 \$1,000. Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes an annual revenue increase to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$1,280 beginning in fiscal year 2025-26 from licensing fees for intermediate care facilities for persons with intellectual disabilities.
