### **An Act to Standardize the Muzzle-loading Season Statewide**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11404, sub-§1-A**, as enacted by PL 2005, c. 280, §2, is amended  
3 by amending the first blocked paragraph to read:

4 The commissioner may terminate this open season at any time in an area if, in the  
5 commissioner's opinion, an immediate emergency action is necessary due to adverse  
6 weather conditions or severe hunting pressure. The length of the special muzzle-loading  
7 season ~~is as follows~~ must be the same in all regions of the State and established by rule.

8 **Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §11404, sub-§1-A**, as enacted by PL 2005, c. 280, §2, is amended  
9 by amending the 2nd blocked paragraph to read:

10 ~~The commissioner shall establish by rule the length of the special muzzle-loading season.~~  
11 ~~The commissioner may establish seasons of different lengths in different regions of the~~  
12 ~~State.~~ The season may extend for no more than 12 hunting days ~~in any part of the State.~~

13 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill establishes that the muzzle-loading-only open season on deer must be the same  
15 in all areas of the State.
