The program trust fund must be established and maintained in accordance with applicable sections of the United States Internal Revenue Code. Subject to review and approval by the Treasurer of State, the program trust fund investment options made available to participants must be selected by the board. Any unexpended balance in the program trust fund at the end of a year may not lapse and must be carried forward to be available for expenditure by the board in the subsequent year for program purposes.'
