Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §8202, sub-§2, ¶A, as amended by PL 1995, c. 665, Pt. FF, §1, is further amended to read:

A. The amount must be paid in 4 equal quarterly payments during the year of attendance. The first payment must be made by July 31st. The amount of tuition and other costs paid for all students is limited to the amount appropriated for this purpose. To be eligible for state funding under this paragraph, a student must have resided reside in Maine with a parent, other relative or guardian for at least 6 months immediately preceding application to the school at the start of the academic year for which state funding is appropriated.

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

SUMMARY

Current law requires that state funding for a student who applies to the Maine School of Science and Mathematics is available only if the student resided in Maine for at least 6 months prior to applying to the school. This bill instead requires that the student reside in Maine at the start of the academic year for which state funds are appropriated. This bill also provides ongoing funds to the Maine School of Science and Mathematics to support
