COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 521, L.D. 814, "An Act to Provide Funding to Area Agencies on Aging for Community-based Services and Programs to Support Older Adults"

Amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph I in the first line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "1987"

Amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph I in the last line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Act" the following: 'of 1965'

Amend the bill in section 3 in paragraph I in the last line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Code," the following: 'Chapter 35.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
