The Department of Environmental Protection shall use the funds transferred in accordance with section 3 and deposited into the Maine Clean Water Fund established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 411-C to provide funding for the repayment of loans held by
26 27	public wastewater systems in accordance with Title 38, section 411-C, subsection 2, paragraph B. The department shall establish a competitive process by which public
28	wastewater systems, including sanitary districts established in accordance with Title 38,

Sec. 3. Transfer. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, on or before January 1, 2026, the State Controller shall transfer \$3,000,000 from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Environmental Protection, Maine Clean Water Fund for funding to support the uses described in section 2 and authorized in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 411-C, subsection 2, paragraph B.

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and changes the title. It authorizes the Maine Clean Water Fund to be used for repayment of loans held by public wastewater systems. It requires the Department of Environmental Protection to establish a competitive process to use \$3,000,000 in funds from the Maine Clean Water Fund to provide funding for the repayment of loans held by public wastewater systems. It requires the department, in evaluating applications for loan repayment and awarding funds under the competitive process, to seek to provide funding to public wastewater systems most at risk of defaulting on their debt. The department is required to make an initial award of funds by July 1, 2026.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes a one-time transfer of \$3,000,000 on or before January 1, 2026, from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Clean Water Fund within the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) for the department to provide funding for the repayment of loans held by public wastewater systems. The bill includes an accompanying Other Special Revenue Funds allocation to the DEP to authorize expenditures related to this purpose.
