## An Act to Expand the Earned Paid Leave Exception

2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §637, sub-§11,</b> as enacted by PL 2019, c. 156, §3 and affected by §4, is amended to read:
4 5 6 7	11. Exception. This section does not apply to an employee covered by a collective bargaining agreement during the period between January 1, 2021 and the expiration of the agreement. This section does not apply to an employer that provides employees with 80 or more hours of paid leave during the calendar year.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill exempts employers that provide employees with 80 or more hours of paid leave during the calendar year from the laws governing earned paid leave.
