Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 3 Whereas, the safety and well-being of victims of domestic violence are of paramount 4 importance; and Whereas, this legislation provides funding for essential services for victims of 5 domestic violence and must take effect before the expiration of the 90-day period to ensure 6 the funding is available at the beginning of fiscal year 2025-26; and 7 8 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 9 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 10 11 therefore, 12 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 13 Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and 14 allocations are made. 15 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF 16 **Purchased Social Services 0228** 17 Initiative: Provides funding for essential services for victims of domestic violence. 18 **GENERAL FUND** 2025-26 2026-27 19 All Other \$4,000,000 \$4,000,000 20 \$4,000,000 21 GENERAL FUND TOTAL \$4,000,000 22 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation 23 takes effect when approved. **SUMMARY** 24 25 This bill provides funding for essential services for victims of domestic violence.
