Be it enacted by the People of the State of Main	e as follows:
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- **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §7503, sub-§13-A,** as enacted by PL 2021, c. 155, §2, is amended to read:
- **13-A. Maine Service Fellows Program.** Develop and administer the Maine Service Fellows Program under section 7506; and
- **Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §7503, sub-§14,** as enacted by PL 1995, c. 54, §1, is amended to read:
- 14. Annual report. Submit an annual report to the Governor, the Legislature and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters by January 31st of each year-; and

Sec. 3. 5 MRSA §7503, sub-§15 is enacted to read:

- 15. Disaster response. In conjunction with the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management, compile a list of volunteers who are available at the request of the Governor during states of emergency to provide emergency response and support services in coordination with the Maine Emergency Management Agency. The list of volunteers must include individuals who completed a term of service through an approved national service position under the Corporation for National and Community Service authorized under 42 United States Code, Section 12651 and veterans.
- **Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.
