#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The Bureau of Revenue Services within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services will require General Fund appropriations of \$3,962,000 in fiscal year 2027-2028 and \$4,041,000 in fiscal year 2028-29 to fund the expansion of property tax exemptions for veterans and survivors of veterans for property tax years beginning on or after April 1, 2026.
