13 14	'Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §2910-A, sub-§4, ¶B, as enacted by PL 2019, c. 182, §1, is amended to read:
15 16 17 18	B. Medical payments coverage in a casualty insurance policy is assignable only by written agreement between the insured and the casualty insurer on a form prescribed or approved by the superintendent. Benefits under medical payments coverage must be applied as directed by the insured.'
19. 20	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
21	SUMMARY
22 23 24	This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment requires the assignment of medical payments coverage to be in writing on a form prescribed or approved by the Superintendent of Insurance.
