1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1718-G, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 28, Pt. A, §2, is amended by amending the section headnote to read:
4 5 6	§1718-G. Requirements for notice to patients of costs for COVID-19 screening and testing and prohibited charges for COVID-19 vaccination for uninsured patients
7 8	Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §1718-G, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 28, Pt. A, §2, is repealed.

10 11	This bill repeals the provision of law that prohibits health care providers from charging uninsured patients for administering a COVID-19 vaccine.
