Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

18 <u>§6001-D.</u> Surveys and questionnaires; parental permission

<u>A public school, public charter school or private school approved for tuition purposes</u> <u>may not administer to a student who is a minor any survey or questionnaire without</u> <u>affirmative written permission from the student's parent for each survey or questionnaire.</u>

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, changes the title of the bill and clarifies that affirmative written permission from a parent is needed for each survey or questionnaire administered by a public school, public charter school or private school approved for tuition purposes.
