COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 410, L.D. 954, "An Act to Amend the Law Governing the Membership of the Government Oversight Committee"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first indented paragraph in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 15 to 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "~~Beginning with the 132nd Legislature, at least one member of the committee must be a member of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over taxation matters~~" and inserting the following: 'Beginning with the 132nd Legislature, at least one member of the committee must be a member of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over taxation matters'

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first indented paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "party;" and inserting the following: 'party.'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This Act applies retroactively to December 4, 2024.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the bill by retaining the provision under current law that requires, beginning with the 132nd Legislature, at least one member of the Government Oversight Committee to be a member of the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over taxation matters. The amendment also amends the bill by adding a retroactivity clause to make this legislation apply retroactively to December 4, 2024.
