2	Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §85, sub-§10 is enacted to read:
3 4 5	10. Municipalities conducting or hosting training. The board shall adopt rules to allow municipalities to conduct or host training for licensing under subsection 3, paragraph <u>A</u> and relicensing under subsection 4, paragraph <u>A</u> .

7 8 9	This bill directs the Emergency Medical Services' Board to adopt rules to allow municipalities to conduct or host emergency medical services licensing and relicensing training.
