Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 4. **Transfer of settlement funds.** Notwithstanding any provision of law to  
12 the contrary, the State Controller shall transfer \$140,000 from the Administration -  
13 Attorney General, Other Special Revenue Funds account within the Department of the  
14 Attorney General from funds received from settlement agreements to the unappropriated  
15 surplus of the General Fund no later than June 30, 2027.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment eliminates the one-time General Fund appropriations to the Department of Corrections of \$244,000 in fiscal year 2025-26 and \$124,000 in fiscal year 2026-27 and replaces them with a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$140,000 in fiscal year 2026-27. The amendment also transfers funds from an Other Special Revenue Funds account within the Department of the Attorney General to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to offset the General Fund appropriation provided.
