COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 413, L.D. 983, "An Act Regarding Service of Notice of Restricted Person Status to Hospitalized Patients"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1-A in paragraph B in the last line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "consent" the following: 'or confidentiality restrictions under hospital policy'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

## SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that a hospital may disclose that a person is a patient to facilitate notice of a weapons restriction notice regardless of patient consent or confidentiality restrictions.
