23	SUMMARY				
24	This amendment replaces the definition of "low-income household" in the bill. The				
25	amendment provides that a low-income household for the purposes of needs-based low-				
26	income assistance for electricity customers is a household that is eligible for a low-income				
27	assistance program administered by the Maine State Housing Authority or eligible for a				
28	means-tested program administered by the Department of Health and Human Services and				
29	that has an income of no more than 150% of the federal poverty level.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes one-time General Fund appropriations of \$7.5 million in fiscal year 2025-26 and fiscal year 2026-27 only to the Maine State Housing Authority for low-income electric ratepayer assistance.

Any additional costs to the Public Utilities Commission to adopt the changes in this bill are expected to be minor and can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.

Any additional savings to the Department of Health and Human Services, General Assistance program, from the provisions of this bill are expected to be minor and can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
