An Act to Allow Municipal Fire Departments with Trained Personnel to Conduct Sprinkler Plan Reviews

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1377, as amended by PL 1997, c. 728, §36, is further amended by enacting at the end a new paragraph to read:

The fire department of a municipality registered by the commissioner under Title 25, section 2448-A may conduct a plan review under this section if the municipal employee conducting the plan review meets the requirements of Title 25, section 2448-A, subsection 2, paragraph B and the municipal fire department establishes a process for the review of a plan that includes the requirements of this section and a requirement of thorough evaluation of a plan to ensure compliance with all applicable codes and standards. If the municipality has reviewed and approved a plan that meets all the requirements of this section, the municipality may issue a permit to the fire sprinkler system contractor.

12 SUMMARY

This bill allows a municipal fire department to conduct a sprinkler plan review if the municipal employee conducting the review is certified as a plan reviewer by the National Fire Protection Association and the municipal fire department establishes a review process that includes a thorough evaluation of a plan to ensure compliance with all applicable codes and standards.
