**Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The bill includes a revenue decrease to the Highway Fund of \$2,853,500 in fiscal year 2026-27 from changing certain motor vehicles from an annual inspection to an inspection every other year.

The Department of Environmental Protection has indicated that eliminating certain inspection requirements could result in the loss of federal funding.
