Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2423-B, sub-§3, as amended by PL 2021, c. 662, §19 and c. 669, §5, is further amended to read:

3. Expiration. A written certification form for the medical use of cannabis under this section is valid for the term provided by the qualifying patient's medical provider, which must be included in the written certification and which may not exceed one year of 2 years.

SUMMARY

This bill changes the maximum term for a medical cannabis written certification from up to one year as determined by a qualifying patient's medical provider to 2 years.
