Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes ongoing annual General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$20,000 beginning in fiscal year 2025-26 to partner with health care providers, community-based health care programs and hospitals to create and disseminate informational materials on issues surrounding perimenopause and menopause.
