- 'Sec. 1. State Court Administrator to study Rumford Courthouse building; report. Resolved: That the State Court Administrator shall perform an inspection and evaluation of the entire space within the building located at 145 Congress Street in the Town of Rumford, including space within the building currently occupied by the judicial branch, the town, the county or any other organization or entity. By February 1, 2027, the State Court Administrator shall submit a report to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over judiciary matters describing:
- 1. All required improvements and modifications, including improvements and modifications required to ensure accessibility and safety, as well as any suggested reallocation of space within the building necessary both to maintain and to expand the District Court services provided within the building; an estimate of the cost for implementing these improvements and modifications; and an estimate of the time required to complete these improvements and modifications; and
- 2. All required improvements and modifications, including improvements and modifications required to ensure accessibility and safety, as well as any suggested reallocation of space within the building necessary both to maintain and to expand the Superior Court services provided within the building; an estimate of the cost for implementing these improvements and modifications; and an estimate of the time required to complete these improvements and modifications.
