1 Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 3 Whereas, the Island Nursing Home in Hancock County has ceased operations, resulting in the loss of a critical resource for the district; and 4 Whereas, the region faces an urgent and ongoing shortage of affordable housing for 5 senior citizens: and 6 Whereas, the Board of Directors of the Island Nursing Home has proposed a redevelopment plan to convert the facility into 24 affordable apartments for senior citizens, 8 which will address this critical need; and 9 10 Whereas, immediate funding is necessary to initiate the renovation project, which has an estimated cost of \$1.2 million to \$1.5 million; and 11 12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 13 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 14 15 therefore. 16 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 17 Sec. 1. Accountability and reporting. The Maine State Housing Authority shall submit a detailed report regarding the conversion of the Island Nursing Home in Hancock 18 County to affordable apartments for senior citizens to the Joint Standing Committee on 19 20 Appropriations and Financial Affairs within 6 months of receipt of funding provided 21 pursuant to section 2. The report must include: 22 1. A breakdown of how the funds have been used; 23 2. A progress update; and 24 3. A financial summary of additional funds raised and any additional funding needs. 25 Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and 26 allocations are made. 27 HOUSING AUTHORITY, MAINE STATE 28 **Housing Authority - State 0442** 29 Initiative: Provides one-time funds to support the conversion of the Island Nursing Home in Hancock County into 24 affordable apartments for senior citizens. 30 31 **GENERAL FUND** 2026-27 2024-25 2025-26 32 \$250,000 All Other \$0 \$0 33 34 \$250,000 \$0 GENERAL FUND TOTAL \$0 35 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation 36 takes effect when approved.
