Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes a one-time General Fund appropriation to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services of \$10,000,000 in fiscal year 2025-26 to provide funding to the Kennebec Water District to expand water service infrastructure in Fairfield in response to perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances, or PFAS, contamination in private wells.
