2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3197 is enacted to read:
3 4	§3197. Nonemergency transportation contracts; impact on community action agency programs
5 6 7 8	Before entering into a contract with an entity to provide nonemergency transportation services that are covered by the MaineCare program, the department shall consider the financial impact that such a contract would have on programs provided by an entity designated as a community action agency pursuant to section 5324, subsection 1.
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12 13	This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services to consider the financial impact that entering into a contract with an entity to provide nonemergency transportation services that are covered by the MaineCare program would have on existing programs provided by community action agencies prior to entering into the contract.
