COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 762, L.D. 1157, "An Act to Amend the Laws Relating to the State's Background Check Center"

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 10 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "a final" and inserting the following: '~~a final~~ an initial'

Amend the bill in section 18 in subsection 10 in paragraph A in the first line (page 4, line 42 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "deposition" and inserting the following: 'disposition'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

### SUMMARY

This amendment makes 2 corrections to the bill. It clarifies that the definition of "contingent offer of employment" in the Maine Background Check Center Act requires an initial background check report and not a final one. It also corrects an error in the bill relating to background check report content by replacing the word "deposition" with "disposition."
